Paris, July 28, 2026 - Racine advised Amethis and Capital Banking Solutions (CBS) on CBS's acquisition of Synapse Risk & Compliance. This transaction strengthens CBS's offerings in compliance and know-your-customer (KYC) and opens up new opportunities for Synapse's international growth.

Backed by Amethis since 2023, CBS is strengthening its offerings in the areas of compliance and risk management. Synapse, a French company specializing in regulatory compliance, third-party risk management, and KYC solutions (BoursoBank, Crédit Agricole, BPCE, Revolut, Toyota Financial Services, etc.), generates €8 million in revenue. Its solutions will complement CBS's CapitalCompliance™ platform.

Following the transaction, the new entity will have consolidated revenue of approximately €54 million and a workforce of 430 employees. As part of this transaction, CBS also refinanced its bank debt, led by BRED alongside BPMED, LCL and BP Rives de Paris, and secured mezzanine financing from CEIDF and SOCADIF. For Amethis, this transaction strengthens the group's technological depth, accelerates its capacity for R&D investment, and supports an ambitious international growth trajectory.
